I'm writing in strong objection to the draft Local Plan proposal SA62 for a demolition and redevelopment 'red-zone' covering Broadwater Farm, Somerset Close, Lido Square, Moira Close, and some houses along Lordship Lane. The proposal would cause massive stress to all concerned, displacement and disruption for years as well as blight and undermine all the successful efforts over decades to build a strong and stable local community and to improve local facilities. It breaches a whole range of planning policies which should protect our community. It is unacceptable & should be withdrawn immediately.
