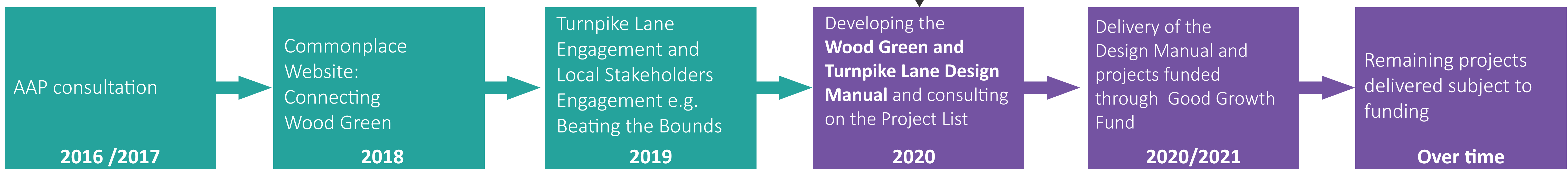
Developing the Wood Green and Turnpike Lane Design Manual

As part of the Manual, we are developing a project list which the local community, council officers, designers and developers will be able to use to deliver improvements to the area. Through this process we expect to:

- ✓ Create a guide which will make the area more attractive, safe and welcoming e.g. new artwork at Penstock Tunnel and patterned transparent fencing by the Library alley way
- ✓ Support an area more accessible and pedestrian-friendly with wider pavements and better crossings and signage
- ✓ Investigate opportunities to create more green spaces with pocket parks and planting e.g. along Turnpike Lane and outside the Library
- ✓ Identify areas where the pavement needs to be cleaner, and suggest new ways to improve waste collection and prevent littering and dumping
