## Multiuse Green and Blue Spaces

### PROTECTING WILDLIFE HABITATS

Promote access and links between natural green spaces whilst safeguarding existing features and support volunteers to preserve the natural space:

- 2 Westbury Banks

### INVESTING IN MAJOR OPEN SPACES

Maximise opportunities to connect and access open spaces whilst also facilitating play, sports, Sustainable Drainage Systems (SuDS), accessibility, active travel and wayfinding:

- 3 Crescent Gardens
- 4 Trinity Gardens
- 5 Nightingale and Avenue Gardens
- 6 Wood Green Common
- 7 Barratt Gardens
- 8 Terrace Gardens
- 9 Ducketts Common Park
- 10 Russell Park
- 11 Potential direct route to Alexandra Palace
- 12 Woodside Park connection

### CREATING POCKET PARKS

Potential underused areas to be transformed into new pocket parks:

- 13 Arnold Bennet Way and Brampton Park Rd
- 14 Bury Road Corner
- 15 Lymington Ave
- 16 Noel Park Pocket Park / Parklet
- 17 Clarendon Rd
- 18 Mayes Rd Pocket Park
- 19 Whymark Avenue Junction with the Sandlings

### BLUE FOR RECREATION

Creating opportunities to use water for recreation whilst also preserving biodiversity:

- 20 Daylighting Blue Infrastructure Feasibility Study
- 21 New River Reservoir for recreation
- 22 Parks and Open Spaces Sustainable Drainage Systems

### GREENING STREETS AND JUNCTIONS

Priority areas for tree planting and Sustainable Drainage Systems (SuDS) to create a connected green network of spaces and destinations:

- 27 Civic Area

### CREATING NEW SQUARES

New potentially accessible squares:

### REINSTATING HISTORIC OPEN SPACES

Reinstate historic open spaces along the High Road through adding green infrastructure, such as SuDS and trees where possible:

- 37 Elses Green
- 38 Gladstone Gardens
