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IF THE NUMBER OF RESIDENCES IS INCREASED AND THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE LIVING THERE IS MORE THAN DOUBLED MY TWO CHIEF CONCERNS ARE DRINKING WATER SUPPLY AND SEWERAGE DISPOSAL. SINCE 2001 (JANUARY) IT BECAME NOTICEABLE THAT EXCESS SURFACE RAINWATER REMAINED IN LARGE PUDDLES. DECEMBER 2009 MR HAZEL ACTED ON PHOTOS AND LETTER AND FLOODING DIMINISHED.

JUNE 2011 MRS NILGUN CANVER (ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSELLOR) ACTED ON PHOTOS AND LETTER BUT HAD TO CALL IN WATER BOARD TO DISCLOSE A

BLOCKAGE IN ONE DUCT OF ABOUT NINE METRES OF ROOTS HAVING GROWN THROUGH GAPS IN THE DUCT.

THIS WAS DEALT WITH BY THE WATER BOARD.

IN FEBRUARY 2013 MR BEVAN ENVIRONMENT COUNSELLOR SAID HE WOULD TRY TO HAVE THE ROUNDABOUT IMPROVED AS ITS EDGES WERE BEING CHURNED UP BY HEAVY VEHICLES COLLECTING REFUSE.

ON 6TH MARCH 2014 PHOTOS AND LETTER WERE SENT TO MR BEVAN SHOWING NO IMPROVEMENT IN THE ROUNDABOUT.

A LETTER WAS SENT TO ME BY MR BEVAN STATING THE OPTION OF LAYING DOUBLE YELLOW LINES TO PREVENT PARKING.

3RD OCTOBER 2014 RESIDENTS RECEIVED STATUTORY NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS WHICH WAS SENT BY ANN CUNNINGHAM HEAD OF TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT.

AS SURFACE WATER DRAINAGE AND SEWERAGE GULLIES WERE INSTALLED SO MANY YEARS AGO, THEY SHOULD RECEIVE PRIORITY OF INSPECTION BEFORE THE NEW DEVELOPMENT IS UNDERTAKEN.

MAINS WATER PRESSURE DOES NOT FLUCTUATE AS IT USED TO; ALTHOUGH IT CEASES ENTIRELY WHEN WORK IS GOING ON AT THE MAINS SUPPLY
