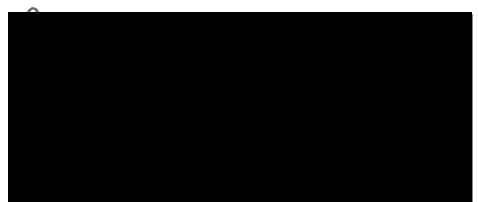

Re: Haringey Local Plan Pre-Submission
Public Consultation 8 Jan. - 4 Mar. 2016

I write to object to the DPDs on the grounds that the aims of said documents, namely the promoting & managing of the built environment, shall have a detrimental impact on the existing population.

The aims, seemingly justified to accommodate a growing population are unsound, as evidenced by the GLA's well-being index, dangerous air pollution levels & worsening life expectancy between east & west Haringey. Ever since the draft London Plan (1999/2000) raised housing targets & increased intensification levels, & required boroughs to comply, the quality of life in Haringey has worsened.

Intensification in deprived areas leads to the collapse of vulnerable communities. This was demonstrated by the national riots, which began in Haringey in 2011.

The aims of the DPDs don't work best for local people's interest, but benefit most the foreign investors & decision-makers whose pockets are over flowing with profit derived from the exploitation of our area.
