We read with dismay about the draft Local Plan (SA62) for part demolition and redevelopment of Broadwater Farm and its surrounding area.

Please abandon such a proposal in favour of improvements to the estate.

It has taken many years to 'turn round' Broadwater Farm and its immediate surroundings from the bad

image created by the 1980s riots. But it most certainly has been turned round. Many residents we

speak to are proud to live on the estate and also to enjoy the park, especially since the lottery grant

enabled a lot of socially useful work to take place. The relatively new 'Hub' community centre is also

providing a useful service to the community, attracting people from different cultures, ages, etc.

It would be tragic if this estate were to go the route that so much of London is going - redevelopment

for the sake of profit and not for the sake of local people.
