What support is available from Carers First



Tailored information and advice to support with their caring role, including preparing for and accessing a carers assessment

On-going wellbeing support, helping carers improve carer's emotional resilience

Peer support groups, training and activities

Signposting and referring into specialist support including benefit advice or for more information about the condition of the person they are caring for

Support with writing an emergency plan to help plan in the event the carer is unable to continue caring in the short term, for example if they fall ill.
