Our priorities priorities are the most important things




 Children and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) will have their own health pathway allowing them to transition from childhood into adulthood



 Annual Reviews from Year 9 onwards will look at a young person's transition into adulthood



 Young people with SEND will have housing that matches their needs



Our communication and contact with families will be better.



 We will make sure the right support is in place to help young people with SEND to get active and stay active



 Young people with SEND to take part in learning, training or employment



 All staff understand the transition support that is needed across Haringey and young people get the support they need at the right time



 Our approach will allow young people with SEND to feel able to talk and to listen and to feel connected



 Young people with SEND and their families will carry on helping us to develop our services



 We will make a detailed list of training, volunteering, and job opportunities



 We will have better information for families and young people about



the move across to adult health services



improving or managing health in adulthood



 All young people with SEND will get the chance of a social life so they can grow and keep friendships into adulthood





Doing a good job

 The SEND Joint Executive Board will watch us to see how well we are doing – they will write short reports to let other people know how we are doing



 We will check to see how well we are doing by working closely with young people and their parent carers



 We will set up the Haringey SEND Youth Forum – they will let us know how we are getting on with our Preparation for Adulthood action plan
