Highgate Cricket and Lawn Tennis Club runs regular inclusive tennis coaching sessions for young disabled people aged 6-21 years. Sessions are pan-disability, and are delivered by an inclusively trained coach with 10 years of coaching experience.

Sessions all equipment involved **is free of charge**. We also have three sports wheelchairs available to borrow.

We encourage disabled young people to come along and try tennis, and invite siblings and friends to join in too!

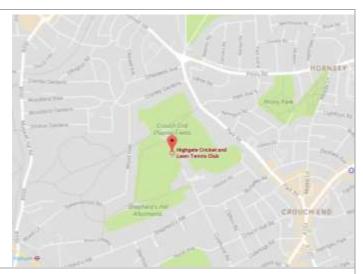
