You recently sent me an email about changes to Haringey's plan, when I used some of the links in your email

I found the local plan of Haringey and I am writing to you as I am a little confused and concerned and would like some answers.

I live in the Tower Gardens Conservation area, in Lordship Lane, on the plan, my block is outlined in brown and the corresponding key on the map indicates that this is a conservation area, and one would hope this means it is protected from development, however, within this line there is another thick beige line and the corresponding key on the map under 'other' states that this line represents - Article 4 direction: Heartlands rail corridor.

Why have residents in this area not been advised of what this means and how it will effect them?

Please tell me:

- 1) what exactly is the heartlands rail corridor
- 2) is a new overhead railway coming straight through our properties
- 3) is a new railway being planned to run under the properties - how will this effect residents and where do we stand in terms of the properties on the tower gardens estate being demolished or damaged
- 4) will building or tunnel work under the foundations effect the properties in terms of vibration
- 5) is the tower gardens conservation estate being ear-marked for ventilation shafts in connection to cross rail
- 6) is the heartlands rail corridor connected to cross rail or is it a totally different rail system

Please provide all information about the plans for Lordship Lane N17 and Tower Gardens conservation area
