A as I am a tenant, then itself I was worried as Page High is identified as a potential ^{Site} ~~Site~~ Agent in Jan 2017 I did receive a letter from dtd 9th June from the deputy director. I was so worried & upset about the future I just poured out my raw emotions in my reply. On the 2nd of March we received a pamphlet ^{to} writing Page High residents for a meeting on the 27th of March at Salvation Army. Again we are asked to express our views as the plans are published. If you kindly allow me, I would like to tell you that I am completely against the plan to demolish Page High. This is a modest social housing complex & has given accommodation for thousands of people young & old, ill & well people for more than 4 (four) decades. Every facilities is on the floor step yet hidden away from the public exposure. Even before we had security system no burglary had ever taken place & have a decent Landlord. We can leave the door open & sleep. It is heart breaking to think that the people who are involved in this scheme or project did not give a ounce of thought of consideration

Towards the emotional trauma of the people of families who live here (giving other accommodation is an entirely different matter) There are people who have been living here for 5, 10, 20, 30, 40 & more than 40 yrs & we belong to the 1st Category as we were the first to start to live here in 1975 when it was first opened I still can remember fresh smell of the brand new flat !!

Even with out a regeneration Wood green is already a mini Oxford in our ~~if~~ If you demolish the factory, library Civic Centre or another public place. It is completely different from uprooting families then again it is Council's property & you have the right to do what you like! But we are all human beings & there is a human side too. To conclude my humble presentation I think even at this stage you have the authority to leave poor old Page high as it is and get on with the other plans for the regeneration of Wood green
